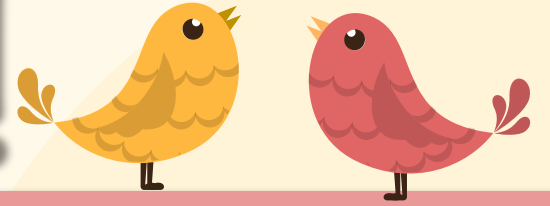

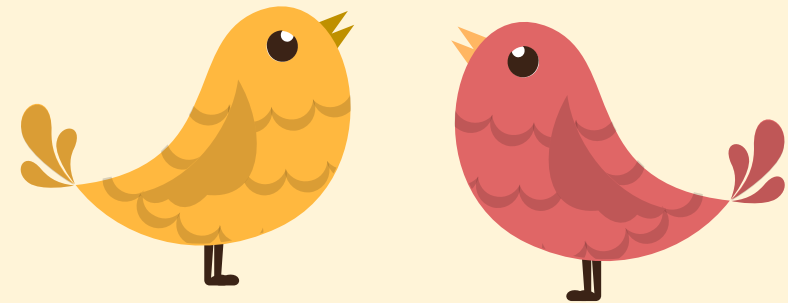

- Full, unlimited access to all approved activities



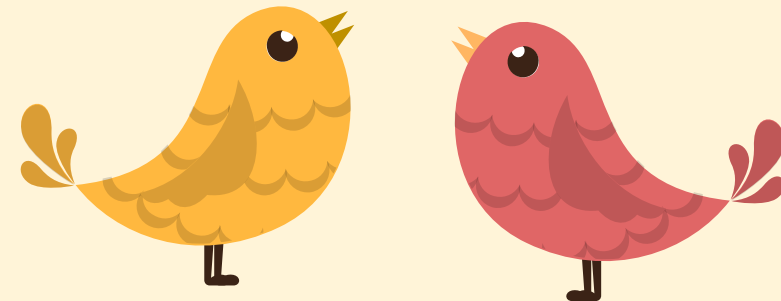

- Arrive at MS 88 at approximately 3:30 PM





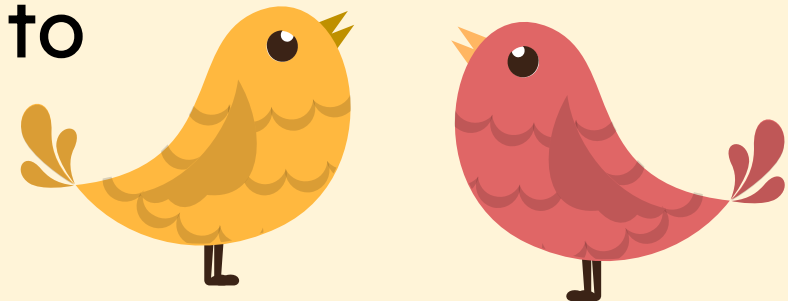
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WHO'S GOING?

- At least one Assistant Principal will attend
- No parents/guardians will be permitted to chaperone this trip

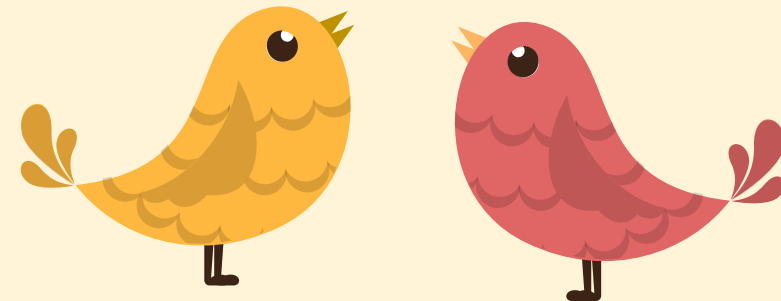


WHO WILL BE INVITED?



As with all of our trips and events, only students who have demonstrated the best of MS 88's Core Values throughout the entire year are eligible to attend.

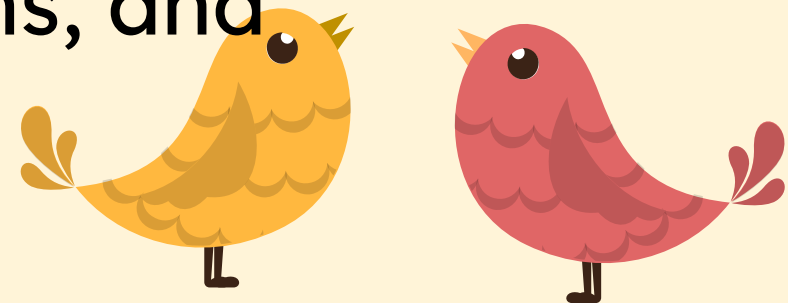
This means that you...



WHO WILL BE INVITED?



- are meeting or exceeding MS 88's Core Values Standards
- have an acceptable record of attendance & latenesses
- have an acceptable record of behavior/conduct
- were hand-selected by teachers, deans, and administrators



HOW AM I BEING EVALUATED?



- 8th grade teachers, deans, and administrators will evaluate students twice - once for December/January, once for February/March
- It's a checklist containing the info from the last side and the question, "Would you recommend this student be eligible to attend the Senior Trip?"
- Receive "yes" from both evaluation periods, you'll be first to receive a permission slip. Receive one "yes" and one "no," you'll be reviewed while other students can return their permission slips.





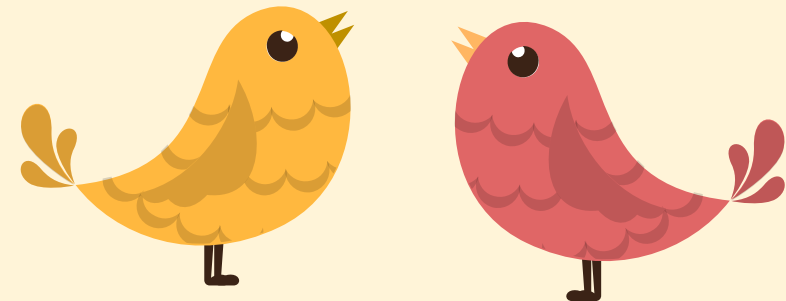

WHAT HAPPENS AT CAMP LAKOTA?



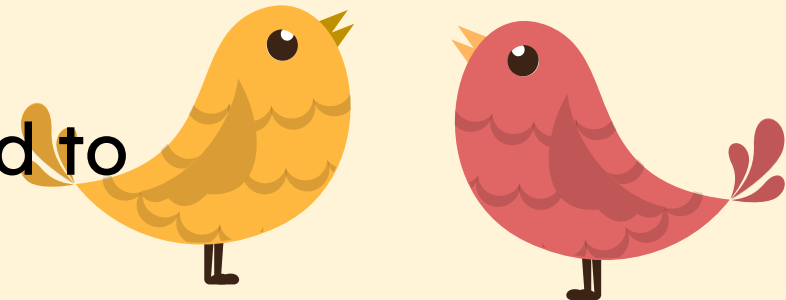
- Prior to departure, students will create cabins of 8-10 students (same gender, from any floor)
- Students are essentially ONLY in their cabins at night and to get changed for activities/meals
- Students will be free to select which activities (hosted by a chaperone) they would like to attend throughout the day



WHAT HAPPENS AT CAMP LAKOTA?



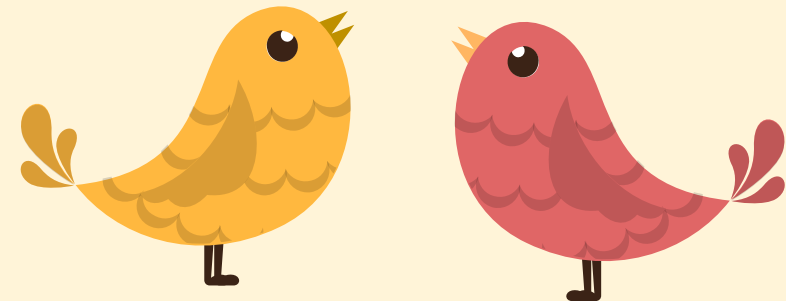
- Students will be supervised by an MS 88 chaperone at all times
- All students will attend all meals together
- All cabins will be checked before “lights out”
- Wake up by 7:30 AM. Lights out by 11 PM.
- All cabins will be monitored overnight
- Phones will be held by chaperones for the majority of the trip. Students will have designated times when they will be permitted to call/text family members.



IS IT A DEALBREAKER?



- If a child thinks they'll be sitting inside their cabin, **this is not the trip for them.** We go outside when it's hot. We go outside when it's raining. We. Go. Outside.
- If a child cannot live without their phone, **this is not the trip for them.** Phones will be available on nature hikes, campfires, and during certain hours of the day to contact parents/guardians.





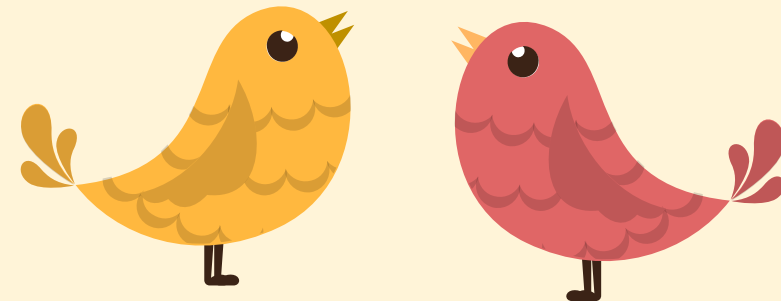

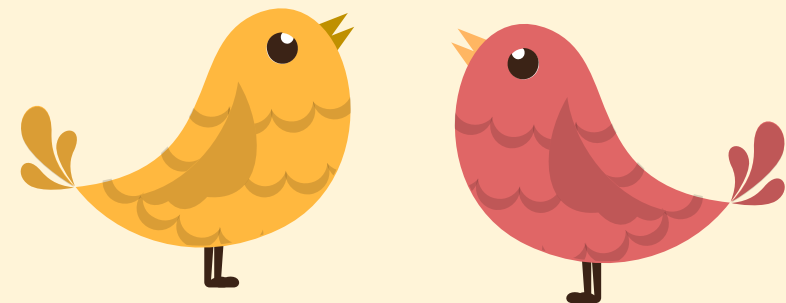
WHAT'S EXTRA?

Yes, you can buy gear even if you're not going on the trip!



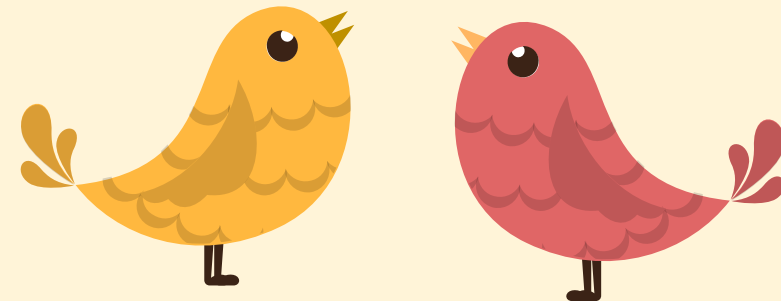

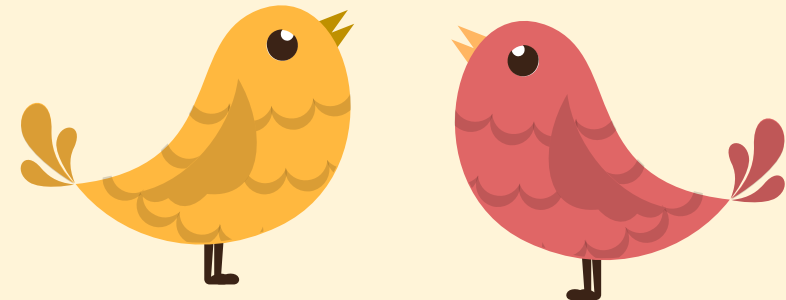

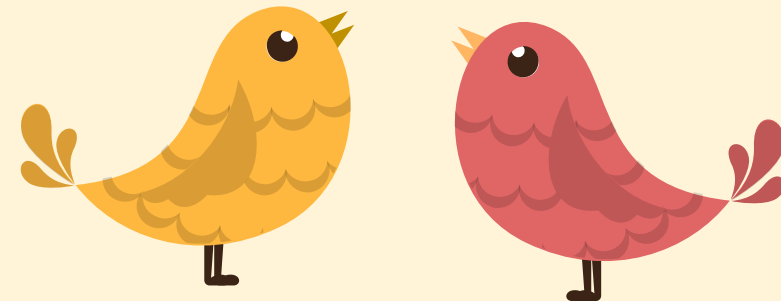

Floor hockey



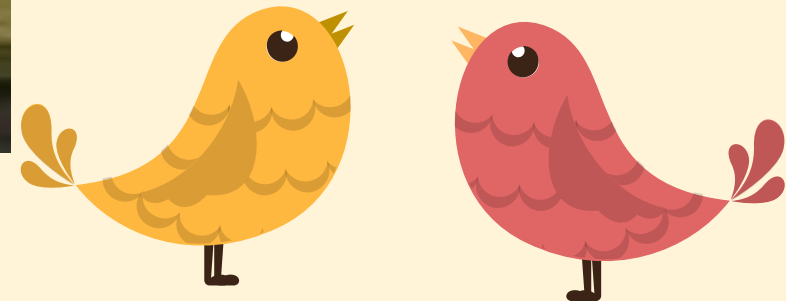
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Sports fields



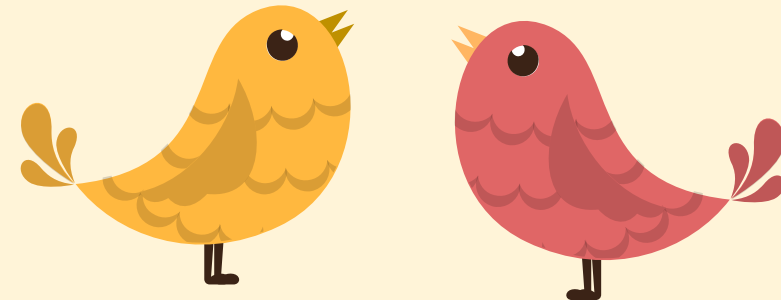
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Cabins



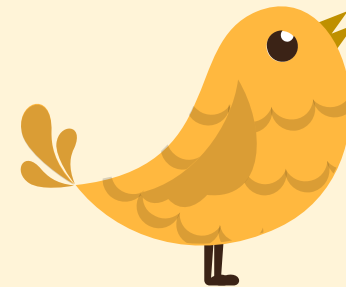
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Cabins (interior)



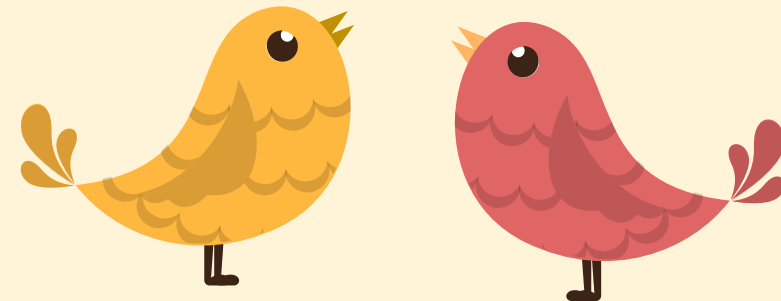

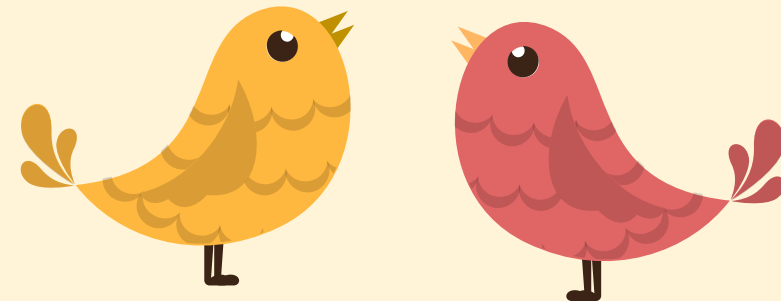

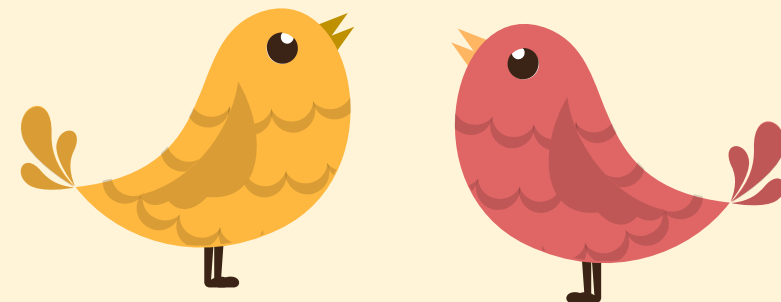

Camp map





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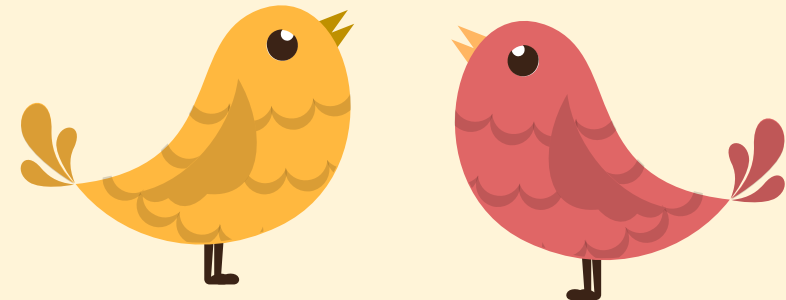

- Selling MS 88 chocolate boxes can help pay for some or all of the trip (\$25 each box)

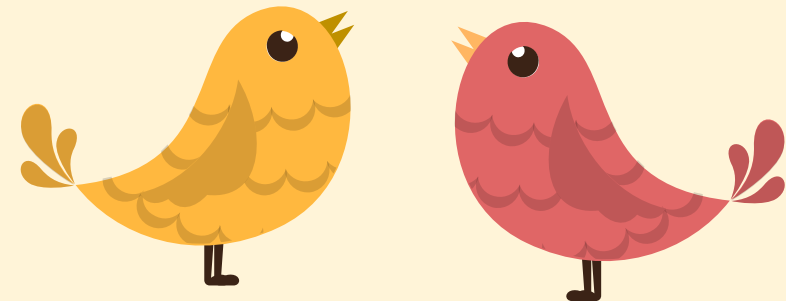

HOW CAN I GO?



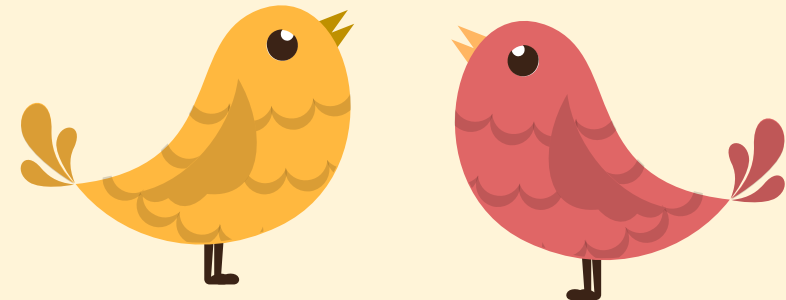
- A link will be provided to submit all payments
